News Release

During the week of December 04-December 10 the police department responded to 73 calls for assistance.

During the day on December 05, a break & enter occurred to a home in the 700 block of Island Road. Entry was gained by breaking the glass in a door. Electronic equipment was stolen.

On December 06, a Break & Enter occurred at a home in the 600 block of Victoria Ave. The person responsible for this Break & Enter has been identified and the stolen property recovered. The matter is currently being referred to Restorative Justice Oak Bay for review and consideration is being given to resolve the matter through mediation.

On December 05 expensive camera equipment was stolen from the Oak Bay Recreation centre. Surveillance photos of the suspect have been obtained and investigation continues.

During the daylight hours of December 06, Break & Enters occurred to residences in the 100 block of Beach Drive and on Kinross street. Electronic items were stolen in both offences.

December 11- a resident on Hampshire Road found a large section of his picket fence had been stolen overnight. Fortunately the fence didn't go far. A nearby resident found the fence had been deposited in the back of his pickup truck by the culprits.

On December 11 at 10 am. Police checked a male in the 2400 block of Beach drive after receiving a complaint that he was attempting near a real estate "lock Box". The male who is well known to police admitted looking at the box but denied he was attempting to break into it to obtain the key.

On December 11 the laundry room of a complex on Elgin Road was entered. Although a minimum amount of coins were stolen, significant damage was done to the laundry machines.
